

Webannex A: Definition of indicators (all indicators stratified by public or private sector)

<b>INDICATOR</b>	<b>DENOMINATOR</b>	<b>NUMERATOR</b>
<b>Antenatal care, four or more visits</b>	Women 15-49, live birth in the last 2 (MICS) years or 3 (DHS) years	4+ visit(s) to any provider
<b>Careseeking for diarrhoea</b>	Live children, 0-59 months, with diarrhoea in the past 2 weeks	Sought treatment from a health facility or provider
<b>Careseeking for pneumonia</b>	Live children, 0-59 months, suspected pneumonia in the past 2 weeks (cough with faster breathe or have difficulty breathing)	Sought treatment from an appropriate health facility or provider
<b>Early initiation of breastfeeding</b>	Live births in the last 2 (MICS) or 3 (DHS) years to women 15-49 (3)	Put to the breast within one hour of birth
<b>Place of delivery</b>	All live births in the last 2 years or 3 years	Delivered at home or in a health facility
<b>Postnatal care for babies</b>	Last-born in the last 2 years	Received postnatal within 2 days of birth
