Interventions (preventive, curative, and promotive)	Components	Target groups
Health education, 3 antenatal visits and one visit during postnatal period	Care during pregnancy, preparation for safe delivery, lactation counseling/breast feeding, prevention of infection, rational newborn care practices, care of normal and low birth weight babies, early detection of illness and care seeking	Mother, mother-in-law, other women and men in family
Care at birth	Cord care, eye care, resuscitation (tactile stimulation, bag and mask ventilation) if asphyxiated	Infants by home visiting
Care of normal newborn	Breast feeding, prevention of infection, thermal care, promotion of good newborn care practices, early detection of illness and care seeking, immunization and growth monitoring, injection vitamin K at birth	
Care of low birth weight infants (<2500 grams)	Breast feeding, warmth by wrapping babies in blankets, prevention of infections, early detection of illness and care seeking, growth monitoring, injection vitamin K at birth	
Identification and treatment of neonates and young infants with infections (sick infant <60 days of age)	Identification of sick infants using simple signs, treatment of local infections (umbilical sepsis, boils, conjunctivitis, diarrhoea), and sepsis (if referral refused), with two antibiotics (injection gentamicin+ oral cotrimoxazole syrup, thermal protection and other supportive care	
Community mobilization	Group health education
