

Supplemental Material 2. Interview Guide

We used Delphi methodology to adapt the interview guide below depending on (1) response saturation and (2) the focus and responsibilities of organizations and participants. The guide may not reflect all questions asked in the interviews.

INTERVIEW GUIDE

Considerations for Strategic Approach

- How do you feel the dapivirine ring could complement other HIV prevention options currently available in your programs?
- Can you describe what type of information would be most important to you to have in supporting planning and costing for integrating the ring into:
 - HIV services?
 - Family planning programs with or without oral PrEP?
 - Other health services with or without oral PrEP?
 - Non-health services with or without oral PrEP?
- How does efficacy/effectiveness affect your enthusiasm about the ring? How would you communicate effectiveness? Which clients or population do you feel would have a need for the dapivirine ring? And what resources would be needed to meet the clients' needs?
- Other novel PrEP interventions, such as long acting cabotegravir, will soon be undergoing introduction and rollout. How do you think imminent HIV prevention interventions should be addressed when planning the ring rollout?

Costing and Financing

- When you reflect on oral PrEP rollout,
 - What are some of the gaps in data that your program would need to plan and cost the ring (e.g., type of staff, training and effort, or other resources)?
 - Recognizing that estimated and actual costs will inherently differ, from your program experience which cost variables seem most critical to re-examine for oral PrEP as the ring is integrated?
 - What do you think are major risks and threats to introducing and scaling up the ring in program? (e.g., communication, effectiveness, supply chain)
 - What do you think are potential opportunities for introducing and scaling up the ring in programs?
- Assuming no change to your current HIV prevention/oral PrEP funding level, what percentage of your funding would you allocate toward the ring? Why?
- Are you aware of or do you support any existing or planned activities that can provide opportunities to generate or evaluate cost data for the ring?

- Are you aware of or do you support existing planning and costing tools in your program or country that would be helpful to incorporate into the resource guide? Are you able to share any of those tools or materials?
- Do you have any additional recommendations for us not covered in this discussion?
